Welcome back!

Happy New Year and welcome back to the second term of school. We hope you all enjoyed Christmas and kept safe over the holidays.

Theme

Year 1 and 2 will be focusing on the theme 'Dinosaurs' during this term. We will be learning about dinosaurs that roamed the world by collecting many facts and gathering information. Where around the world have dinosaurs been found? Explore dinosaur bones and fossils, create models and volcanos.

There will be opportunities for the children to write a description, an information book about a dinosaur, a wanted poster and an imaginary story.

If you have any resources / books to reinforce our class theme 'Dinosaurs' the children are welcome to bring them in. Please ensure that your child's name is clearly written on the resources.

Reading

Reading sessions continue to be conducted on a daily basis. Many reading comprehension exercises will be practiced during the term to develop the children's reading comprehension skills.

We encourage the children to read as often as they can, and kindly ask you to record any comments into the reading record. They will need to keep their reading record and book in their plastic wallets and bring in to school once they are able to read the book confidently and recall main events.

Mathematics

The children will develop and apply their measuring, money and time skills during the second term. Opportunities will be given for them to measure in the classroom and outdoors, build using various measurements and lots of problem solving.

Shape – the children will learn to draw 2D and 3D shapes, name shapes and identify their properties, sort and classify shapes and much more.

We kindly ask you to practice times tables - 2, 5, 10 and 3 with your child at home.
